Pop Up's are being held monthly. They are a collective hui where whānau select partner agencies to support them to move forward in their journey towards their dreams and aspirations.


The next Pop Up's are 9th November in Feilding and 23rd November in Palmerston North. Talk to your Kaiwhakaarara if you are interested in attending.

Kai Swap, provides an alternative way of gathering and sharing knowledge about maara kai and nutrition. With these tools, we can support whanau together achieving a positive impact towards their hauoranga.

Kai swap in August completed a plant drop along with flip chart recipes. This provided whānau with the opportunity to plant their own maara some whānau improvised and designed how they would do their maara with alternative things around the whare.
